

LIVING REGULATIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTS

(Quoted from Regulations on receiving, arranging accommodation, collecting fee, student activity regime for international students staying in Dormitory)

1. IMPORTANT REMARKS:

- 1.1. Making full and timely payments for the living fee and other fees as prescribed (if any); keeping receipts for comparison or refund procedures when necessary;
- 1.2. Self-preserving personal property and belongings;
- 1.3. Complying with the Dorm's official community hours: **opening time: 5:00, closing time: 22:00;**
- 1.4. Don't decorate, repair or renovate rooms, relocate accommodation, equipment or materials of the dormitory out of position having been arranged intentionally;
- 1.5. Being responsible for preserving the keys, property, equipment and items in the room; for using them for the right purpose in accordance with the regulations of equipment provided or permitted to use (*computers, radio cassettes, irons, lights, personal fans, etc.*); for carefully using electronic equipment; for unplugging the device from the power sockets after use; for checking and switching off all appliances and water before leaving the room;
- 1.6. Being responsible for compensating for self-damage or self-loss of the facilities of the dormitory;
- 1.7. Complying with regulations on temporary residence registration instructed by the Dormitory; being absent for 02 days or more must be reported to a dormitory officer;
- 1.8. Maintaining general hygiene in the dormitory; arranging furniture, personal items neatly and orderly; outfits, attitudes and behaviors must be appropriate for the university environment; drying clothes and personal items at the right place;
- 1.9. Residing in your assigned bed and room; male residents mustn't visit female residences or vice versa;
- 1.10. Following the request of Dormitory Director about the residence relocation when it is necessary or has a good reason;
- 1.11. Strictly complying with all regulations on fire and explosion prevention, carefully using electronic items.

2. PROHIBITIONS:

- 2.1. Stockpiling, using banned goods, smuggled goods; weapons; explosive substances, toxic chemicals; trading in, storing, using drugs and preparations of drugs in all forms;
- 2.2. Using alcohol, beer, tobacco and/or other stimulants in the boarding residences;

- 2.3. Storing, using electric cooking utensils, magnetic, oil, gas and alcohol stoves, charcoal, firewood; as well as other explosive and flammable substances;
- 2.4. Organizing or participating in gambling and betting activities in any form;
- 2.5. Acts of vandalism and of using the university property for improper purposes;
- 2.6. Making noise; or gathering crowds of people that affect the living and studying in the dormitory area;
- 2.7. Arbitrarily introducing outsiders into the dormitory area; Letting others borrow and use the boarding pass, keys, equipment in the room, etc.;
- 2.8. Performing acts and activities in violation of the State's regulations and laws; don't carry out study activities during the time of in-residence, but carrying out extracurricular activities in violation of the laws of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.

(Note: Save water & electricity)

This regulation applies to boarding students, international ones, visitors when living, working, residing and communicating at Ton Duc Thang University's Dormitory.
