## Overview:

## Introduce to the Program:

The Master degree training program of the major Finance and Banking helps learners to improve, update, enhance the business and management knowledge and the in-depth knowledge in the field of Finance and Banking, and apply that knowledge to practice activities into building business strategies, financial managing, accounting, tax and auditing at enterprises, financial institutions such as banks, insurance companies, investment companies, financial services and non-profit organizations. Besides, the learners of this program are equipped with the skills and ability to be lecturers in universities and colleges, to study the doctoral degree, and to do advanced researches in the field of Finance and Banking.

## Program structure:

The program is divided into 3 large courses which are progressed in 3 semesters, as below:

- **1st Semester:** Students will study general and fundamental courses.
- **2nd Semester:** Students will study specialist course.
- **3rd Semester:** Students prepare master's dissertation in 6 months.
